

1/2M FLEE FROM TERRIBLE IVAN

HALF a million people were ordered to flee their homes in Jamaica yesterday as Hurricane Ivan swept in — after leaving this trail of destruction in neighbouring Grenada.

The death toll rose to 32 as thousands of buildings and boats were destroyed on the Caribbean Island.

It was feared many more would perish as the hurricane last night slammed into Jamaican capital Kingston — home to a million people.

Armed private guards began patrolling against looters in Montego Bay.

Florida was also put on alert — which would make it the third hurricane to hit the state in a month.

The National Hurricane Centre said Ivan could hit the Keys as a Category 4 hurricane — with winds up to 155mph.
